This policy does not offer exemption from academic requirements for Southern Union degrees; adjustment only applies to grades in individual courses. All courses for which a grade is awarded at Southern Union will remain on the transcript. Courses for which a grade has been deleted from the cumulative GPA will have a notation placed on the transcript that the grade has been excluded from the earned hours and the cumulative GPA. When a course is repeated more than once, all grades for the course – excluding the first grade – will be employed in computation of the cumulative grade point average. Grade adjustment is not reversible.
